



REGISTRATION

How do I register?

Registration can only be done via the Look Good Feel Better website and all players must submit their individual details regardless of which entry option you choose.

- Individual Entry players pay their own entry fee and register their details, quoting their team name
- Team Entry a team captain pays the entry fees for all team members and is sent joining instructions to forward to team members
- Claim Team Place a team member sent joining instructions by a 'Team Entry' captain clicks here to register their details

You will be asked to pay a registration fee which is a direct donation to the charity. Registration is £35 per player.

How many players can be in a team?

The games will be played with a traditional 7 players so a minimum of 7 players are required to make a team but you can register up to 10 players (3 substitutes). There will be a roll-on-roll-off substitution process going on so all players can have equal playing time.

Mixed teams can have a maximum of 3 males on court at any one time, and a maximum of 1 male per court third.

All registering players must be 16+ years of age.

What ability does my team need to be to take part?

Any ability!

Teams will be split into pools on the day, and we will do our best to match teams of similar ability. This is a friendly and fun charity tournament, and we ask that all teams show good sportsmanship and kindness to one another so as to ensure everyone has a great experience.





What happens if I get an injury or can no longer take part in the tournament?

As stated in our terms and conditions, if you can no longer take part in the tournament then you can transfer your place to someone else free of charge. You will need to organise to find a replacement player for your team. Unfortunately, we cannot offer you a refund on your place.

ON THE DAY

Feeling a bit rusty or never played before?

Don't worry, there will be a special coaching session at the beginning of the day to give all teams a refresher on the rules of the game. England Netball coaches and professional players will also be on hand throughout the day to offer support and advice so you and your team can play with confidence.

What support will be in place for teams on the day?

England Netball umpires and staff will manage the running of the games and will be there to support teams whilst on court. Bibs, balls, and all game equipment will be provided by England Netball.

Look Good Feel Better staff and volunteers will also be on hand throughout the day for any questions or support.

A professional first aid provider will be always on site at the event in case of an emergency.

Getting to the venue

Parking

There is an on-site car park at the Sports and Wellness Hub which operates a ticketless car parking system using Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) software.

All visitors can park on-site at the Sports and Wellness Hub, however, please note that charges will apply. After your visit to the Sports and Wellness Hub, you will be required to pay on exit at the Pay machines at the prevailing rate. At the machine, you will be prompted to enter your vehicle registration, and will then see the camera photo of the vehicle as it entered the car park and be asked to confirm your car.

Food & Drink

You are welcome to bring food and drink into the venue with you. There is a Café Nero inside the Sports & Wellness Hub as well as variety of cafes and restaurants on the University Campus.

Every £50 which is raised will help to fund a place for someone living with cancer to attend a Look Good Feel Better wellbeing workshop and receive vital advice and support whilst undergoing cancer treatment.

Over the 4 years the tournament has been running, over £140,000 has been raised which has provided direct support to over 2,800 people living with cancer.
