Terms & Conditions

Fundraising & Registration

As Registration fees into the tournament go directly to the charity and form part of the money raised to fund our cancer support services, they are nonrefundable. If in the eventuality you can no longer participate in the tournament for any reason, you will be invited to transfer your place to someone else free of charge.

By taking a place in the tournament you understand that this is a fundraising event and therefore do your best to raise a minimum of £50 per player which will help fund a place at one of our wellness Workshops for someone living with cancer. If you are unable to raise any money, you can instead make a direct donation to the charity.

Teams

Teams need to be a minimum of 7 players and a maximum of 10. All individual players must be registered and agree to the terms and conditions outlaid.

Personal health and fitness

By entering the Look Good Feel Better Netball Tournament you shall be deemed to acknowledge and understand that participation is potentially hazardous. It is your responsibility to make sure you are medically fit and capable of participating in the event. The event organisers reserve the right, in its absolute discretion, to stop any participant from taking part if the individual is deemed unfit to participate, including mid-event removal where necessary.

Participation in the event is entirely at your own risk. By entering the event, participants acknowledge that those involved in the organisation and staging of the event shall not be liable for death, injury, loss or damage arising from participation in the event save to the extent that it is caused by their negligence.

Covid-19 guidance

Look Good Feel Better is committed to as far as possible ensuring the health and safety of all those involved in the tournament, and to providing as safe and suitable an environment as possible during this COVID-19 pandemic. If persons are displaying COVID-19 symptoms, or if anybody in their household is displaying



COVID-19 symptoms, or if they are otherwise selfisolating (either due to a recent positive COVID-19 test or otherwise), we ask that you do not attend.

Look Good Feel Better reserve the right to ask players and spectators to use the NHS COVID pass in order to attend the event. This will show proof of vaccination or any PCR tests that have been undertaken. Further details of the NHS COVID Pass is available at <u>Using the NHS COVID Pass – NHSX</u>. If you are exempt from testing or vaccination, you must self-declare this medical exemption directly with us. Details of this requirement will be communicated prior to the event.

Tournament Cancellation

Should the tournament have to be cancelled for any reason, including due to Covid-19, Look Good Feel Better will automatically transfer all registrations to a new event date or offer all players a refund within 30 days of cancellation. We will notify all registered players of any changes as soon as is practicable.

Existing medical conditions

It is your responsibility to advise the event organisers prior to the start of the event of any pre-existing medical condition, disability, relevant medications being taken and allergies that may be relevant in the administration of any medical assistance required or in your ability to take part in the event. In particular you are advised that you should not participate in an event if suffering any cold or flu-like systems or if you have any other existing illness or injury which might reasonably be expected to affect your performance and your ability to take part in the event.

Medical treatment while participating in an event

By entering this event, you are confirming that should you require any medical treatment during your attendance at the event, whether before, during or after the actual event, such treatment may be administered by the on-site First Aid personnel.

Participants and Spectators

Event organisers will use reasonable endeavours to ensure the safety of participants and spectators. Signage is in place to guide attendees.

Parents of spectating children and adults charged with the supervision of spectating children must ensure their children are supervised at all times.

participation as a spectator in the event save to the extent that it is caused by their negligence.

Event Ejection

Event organisers have the right, in their absolute discretion, to refuse to allow you to participate in the event either at the start or to continue participation at any point during the event, should you be deemed to behave inappropriately or give cause for concern that your continued participation may cause offence or injury to yourself, any spectators or other participants. Failure to comply with any instruction from event officials will result in ejection from the event and may also result in you being reported to the police.

Use of Images

By taking part in the event you grant full and irrevocable permission to Look Good Feel Better UK to use any photographs or video content for charity and England Netball related marketing collateral such as website, social and print that may include your image.

Collection and use of information

Your personal information will only be used by us, event organisers for purposes in connection with this event. By entering the event you grant full and irrevocable permission for us to pass any medical details you have given us to the medical teams operating on the day of the event.
